GENERAL INFORMATION

All students must apply for admission and receive an acceptance letter from the Admissions Office.

The University reserves the right to cancel courses due to insufficient registration and to alter the schedule.

Courses numbered 101-199 are for freshman students, 201-299 for sophomores, 301-399 for juniors, and 401-499 for seniors.

It's important to plan your courses carefully to avoid making changes after registration. Advisors can provide guidance, but it's the student's responsibility to know and meet the requirements as stated in the Bulletin

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT

Students must complete their registration by the published deadline in the Calendar. Only registered students are permitted to attend classes/clinical/practicum/field experience after the last day to complete registration. Failure to do adhere to this deadline will result in the student having to withdraw for the semester.

COURSE SELECTION

All course selection must be made **before or by the last day to add** a course as published in the calendar. No approvals will be given to students to add course or begin registration after the last day to add a course.

ADVISORS

While students may feel free to seek counsel from staff members at all times, it is to the students' advantage at the time of registration to receive special assistance in matters of curriculum requirements and defining the general outline of a good academic program. While planning his or her program, the student is assigned an academic advisor who is available for consultation.

PRE-REQUISITES

Some degrees and classes have specific prerequisites, which are listed along with course descriptions in the University's Bulletin. Students will be required to withdraw from classes for which they have not met the prerequisites.

LAB FEES/LECTURE NOTES & LAB MANUALS

Please refer to the course schedule for information regarding lab fees. Additional details can be obtained from the respective departments.

CHAPEL/ASSEMBLY

Chapel/Assembly is held on Mondays at 3:05 - 4:20 p.m., in the Social Sciences Auditorium. Attendance is required of all students.

ATTENDANCE REGULATIONS

- Students are required to attend all scheduled classes and laboratories.
- Students must sign the daily attendance registers provided by lecturers.
- Irregular attendance may result in lowering a student's course grade.
- Absence or leave of absence does not exempt students from the required class or lab work.
- Three tardiness are counted as one absence
- The instructor determines the final grade while applying these regulations.

COURSE LOAD

Correspondence courses or work being done towards the removal of an incomplete are considered in calculating the total study load. Non-credit courses are counted at full value of the student's load. A student's course load will be governed by his financial status and his work program. The recommended guidelines for working students are as follows:

<u>COURSE LOAD</u>	<u>WORK LOAD</u>
1 – 11 credits	20-30 hours per week
12 – 16 credits	16-20 hours per week

Students with poor performance in work or study will be asked to re-adjust their schedule or to withdraw from the university. Students on academic probation for the first time may not register for more than twelve (12) credits. Those on academic probation for two consecutive semesters will have their loads further reduced to eight (8) credits. Those on academic probation for three (3) consecutive semesters will be asked to withdraw from the university for one academic year. Foreign students may not register for less than 12 credits without the permission of the Vice President for Student Development and Services. Students are permitted to register for a maximum of twelve (12) credits only in the Third Semester/Summer.

COURSE OVERLOAD

Students with good performance in study may be permitted to take extra credits, according to the following guidelines.

<u>Overall GPA</u>	<u>Course Load</u>
3.00 - 3.49	17 credits
3.50 - 3.89	18 credits
3.90 - 4.00	19 credits

A final year student who does not meet the above GPA requirements, and wishes to take an overload of no more than 1-2 credits must complete and obtain the required approvals on the overload form. This form is available on the university's website. For the Third Semester, students may register for a maximum of 12 credits only.

CLASS CONFLICTS

Students should not be advised to register for two classes, which convene at the same time.

ADMISSION TO CLASSES

No student will be admitted to a class without proof of proper registration for that class.

CREDIT BY EXAMINATION (CBE)

Credit by Examination is a legitimate way for students to earn academic credits. In this regard, please note the following:

- ✎ CBE is not a means by which failing grades can be changed.
- ✎ CBE assumes prior knowledge on the part of the student, and documentary proof of such must be provided with the CBE form.
- ✎ CBE's must be completed during the first year of study.
- ✎ CBE must be administered within the first two weeks of the semester (see Calendar of Events).
- ✎ The University is not obligated to give instructions to students for CBE.
- ✎ Grades awarded for courses completed by CBE are S (satisfactory) or U (Unsatisfactory), and they are not used in computing GPA's.
- ✎ Be advised that this can be a disadvantage.

INDEPENDENT STUDY/TOPICS IN

All pre-designated "Independent Study/Topics In" courses must be properly registered for on the Aeorion with the permission and approval of the relevant instructor by completing and submitting the Independent Study/Topics In Card obtainable at the Registrar's Office.
