Methods of Social Research I, II and III are NOT offered in the 3rd semester (i.e. Summer Classes), they are ONLY offered in the first and second semester in an academic year, please be guided.

****Please note that PSYC131 Professional Writing Seminar and SOCI131 Professional Writing Seminar are the same class, however, all Psychology degree majors are required to select PSYC131, and all Behavioral Sciences degree majors and Criminology and Criminal Justice Majors are required to select SOCI131.**
