

Students who are interested in this offer will be required to pay the difference in the graduation fee for May 2025 (\$600.00TT). Once approval is granted, all other May 2025 graduation procedures and processes are applicable.

GRADUATION FEE

The Graduation fee is \$1,100.00TT. Graduation fees are a standard part of university graduation exercises globally. The graduation fee covers a range of costs including but not limited to diplomas, diploma holders, transcripts, regalia, photos, and other administrative and processing costs. The deadline for payment of the graduation fee is **Wednesday**, **May 14, 2025**.

PAYMENT OF GRADUATION FEES

Students can make Graduation Payments via the following methods:

GENERAL INFORMATION

Commencement Tickets

Each graduate will receive two (2) Tickets for the Commencement ceremony. All seating is by general admission. All guests attending the ceremony MUST have a ticket (graduands do not need a ticket). Tickets will be distributed by the Registrar's Office along with graduation regalia. Tickets admit one individual. Seats will not be reserved for individuals arriving thirty (30) minutes after the start of the programme. Guests are strongly encouraged to present their Tickets at the door for reserved seating at the Commencement ceremony.

The University is not responsible for lost or misplaced Tickets. Replacement Tickets will not be available. The selling or buying of University Commencement Tickets is strictly prohibited. Please be cautious of offers to sell or buy Commencement Tickets. Tickets hold NO OFFICIAL RESALE VALUE. Commencement Tickets are solely for the purpose of allowing the friends and relatives of graduating students to attend the ceremony. All unwanted Tickets should be returned to the Records Office if a graduate or guest(s) no longer plans to attend the Commencement Exercise.

Admission of Children

All children need Tickets unless a child is small enough to be held on the lap of an adult during the event.





Ushers

Ushers will be at all entrance and exit points to assist guests with seating and to give directions and assistance in other areas. The ushers have been trained to take special care of you at the graduation ceremony. Please follow their lead to ensure that the ceremony flows smoothly and all guests are satisfied. If you have any questions or needs, please direct them to an usher nearest to you.

Note. During the Commencement Ceremony, guests will NOT be allowed to enter during the processional, and after the Commencement Ceremony has started guests will be PERIODICALLY ushered into the available seats.

General Seating

Ushers will guide guests to their designated seating in the Auditorium. Once the Main Auditorium reaches full capacity, guests will be directed to the Overflow area for additional seating.

There is designated seating for persons with disabilities or individuals with special needs at the University Auditorium, however, availability is limited. We ask that families with special needs notify the Registrar's Office and arrive **an hour and a half** in advance of the ceremony in order to liaise with an usher. To accommodate everyone with accessibility needs, only one guest per person with special needs will be allowed to sit in the designated area during the ceremony.

General Parking

There are general parking spaces on the campus and its surroundings. These areas are as follows:

- 1. Northern Car Park north of the Auditorium
- 2. Forde Library Car Park located north of the Library
- 3. Southern Car Park located on the Royal Road south of the Community Hospital Medical Clinic
- 4. Community Hospital Medical Clinic Car Park located on the compound of the Community Hospital Medical Clinic
- 5. Campus Blvd. South between Main Drive and old Linda Austin Hall
- 6. Kennedy Arts Centre
- 7. VIP Parking at Social Sciences Building

Parking attendants will be available to direct you to a spot.





Special Parking

Individuals with family members who have special needs may drop off in front of the University Auditorium. Please see your nearest USC usher or parking attendant upon arrival. **Drivers with special needs will be accommodated at the Social Sciences carpark.**

Photography

A University photographer will be taking photos as graduates walk across the stage at the Commencement ceremony. Graduates will receive one printed photo upon collection of/mailed with their degree. **Personal picture-taking can be done before or after the ceremony.** While we recognize that getting a picture in the moment is important, parents and well-wishers should remain seated. Please show discretion when taking pictures and do not block others or aisles.

Public Facilities

There are restrooms located in and around the University Auditorium. Please ask your nearest usher to direct you to the one closest to you.

ACADEMIC HONORS

Undergraduate academic honors will be announced when the names are read during the Commencement Ceremony:

- Cum Laude denotes a cumulative GPA of 3.50-3.74
- Magna Cum Laude denotes a cumulative GPA of 3.75-3.89
- Summa Cum Laude denotes a cumulative GPA of 3.90 or above
- Graduate students do not receive academic honors

*Graduation Disclaimer:

Documents and written pronouncement of academic honors designation and completion will only be deemed final and valid when they bear the official stamp, seal and signature of the President of the University of the Southern Caribbean and the President of the Board of Trustees.

REGALIA DISTRIBUTION AND RETURN

Before collecting regalia, all students must:

- 1. Receive financial clearance
- 2. Receive Charge Slip (from student finance office)
- 3. Read, Fill and submit the Regalia Contract. Click HERE to access the Regalia Contract.

 Note. You would be required to upload your Charge Slip when submitting this contract.

ACADEMIC ATTIRE

Preparing to march to "Pomp and Circumstance" requires wearing the traditional graduation cap and gown. Your academic dress will depend on the degree you will be receiving. The academic regalia consists of a cap, gown, hood/collar, tassel and honor stole (if applicable).

Here's how to wear your cap and gown:

- a. The graduation cap is worn flat on the head, parallel to the floor. The front point of the cap should be centered on the forehead.
- b. Graduation caps are **NOT** to be decorated.
- c. The graduation gown should fall midway between the knee and ankle (mid-calf).
- d. Tassels are usually worn on the right side and shifted to the left upon conferral of degrees.
- e. Flowers and jewelry should not be worn on the academic gown.
- f. Gowns can be accessorized with specific regalia like stoles, honor cords, kente cloth, and medallions in keeping with the traditions of the school.

NB: Complete academic regalia is required to participate in the Commencement Ceremony.

COMMENCEMENT ATTIRE

Male - Black trousers, Black dress shoes and light-colored dress shirt (tie optional) no bow ties allowed.

Female - Black **comfortable** shoes, a lightweight dress, blouse or skirt. Dress/skirt length should NOT exceed the hem of the robe. In the event that trousers are worn by females they should be black.

Please take note that USC's dress code policy remains in effect (No jewelry except wedding bands and watches). Please note that the dress code will be strictly enforced. Graduands not adhering to the stated dress code will not be permitted to march.





Arrival and Vesting of Graduates

Graduands must arrive **one-and-a-half hours** before graduation commencement for registration and vesting.

N.B. Graduands are expected to arrive fully robed and are advised to walk with at least six safety pins and two hair clips to hold your hood and cap in place.

GRADUATING IN ABSENTIA

Attendance at the Commencement is mandatory (except with approved absentia form). The request to Graduate in Absentia form must be submitted by students who are unable to attend the commencement ceremony scheduled for Sunday, May 18, 2025. The absentia fee is \$900.00TT. The deadline for payment of the absentia fee is Friday, April 4, 2025. In order to successfully submit this form, proof of payment must be attached. Persons who fail to submit the form by the stipulated deadline will be required to pay the full graduation fee of \$1,100.00TT. Persons graduating in absentia will receive their graduation cap and tassel along with their diploma, which will be distributed from May 26, 2025. CEREMONY DETAILS AND INSTRUCTIONS

The University of the Southern Caribbean understands the significance of completing this educational milestone in our student's life journey. Thus, our graduation exercises seek to allow students the opportunity to embrace, appreciate and celebrate this accomplishment, not just in a few hours of a single day but over a three (3) day period.

Consecration – virtual service

As a Seventh-day Adventist institution, importance is placed on holistic education. The Consecration service is intended to help the graduand focus their attention on consecrating their lives to Christ as this journey comes to an end and others begin.

Baccalaureate – face to face

Traditionally, a baccalaureate service is a religious worship service held by a university for its graduating class, their families and friends in celebration of the completion of higher education. Throughout the service, graduates and their families and friends are offered a more intimate opportunity to pause and reflect on this milestone.

Saturday, May 17, 2025, 10:30 am

Guests are to be seated by 10:00 am @ University Auditorium, USC Main Campus. Graduands are **NOT** required to wear regalia for the Baccalaureate service.

Commencement – face to face

The Commencement Ceremony is an academic exercise in which degrees are conferred upon graduates. It is the official process by which the University confers degrees on the graduating class upon the successful completion of all academic requirements. At this ceremony, all graduates and participating faculty **must** wear official academic attire.

Procession Formation

Graduands are expected to be dressed and seated in formation. Please be on time. Graduands are required to be present at both the Baccalaureate and Commencement exercises.

Seating

All candidates will march from the Administration Building to the University Auditorium. They will then be guided to the reserved area at the front where their seats are located on the left and right. A seating chart will be posted for viewing.

Receiving Your Diploma - Commencement Ceremony

Candidates will be given their name cards on Sunday before the Commencement exercise. Your School Dean will instruct you to stand at the appropriate time for the presentation of diplomas. You will rise according to your schools. To receive diplomas, the candidates on the front row will move towards the left of the platform and give their name cards to the Registrar's Office personnel standing closest to the Dean. After each name is called, the candidate will move towards the President who will present their diploma jackets. Candidates are to return to their seats and be seated. After all candidates are presented by the Dean, candidates would be asked to stand and face the audience for a round of applause.

Ceremony Etiquette

At USC the distribution of diplomas is a quick and orderly process. Kindly adhere to the following guidelines:

- Make sure that when you show pride for your graduate, friend or colleague that you aren't drowning out the recognition of another. Life's milestones deserve everyone's full attention.
- Turn off your cell phones and resist the urge to text until the entire ceremony is over.
- Remain in your seat until the last graduate receives their diplomas so that they feel properly acknowledged.
- Men should remove their graduation caps during the school song, National Anthem and prayer. Guests are asked to mute or lower the volume of their cellular phones.

LETTERS OF COMPLETION

Letters of completion are available to all May 2025 Candidates.

- 1. In order to receive a Letter of Completion, students must receive financial clearance and academic clearance.
- 2. A shared document between the Office of Student Finance and the Office of the Registrar will be regularly updated to indicate students who have received financial clearance.

DIPLOMA DISTRIBUTION

Official diplomas will be made available for collection at the Records Office from Monday, May 26, 2025. Diploma collection will be subject to financial clearance from the Ministry of Education and/or the University of the Southern Caribbean. Diplomas can be delivered (TTPost or FedEx) or collected in person.

Trinidad & Tobago Delivery - TTPOST - The cost of the delivery must be covered by the student. The cost of mailing via TTPost is \$50.00TT.

International Delivery - FedEX - Mailing rates tend to fluctuate and can only be provided closer to the date of dispatch. Please see below for the estimated FedEx rate for various islands/territories

The request for mailing of diplomas must be submitted in writing. The letter/email must include the following (along with proof of payment) to the Records Office (transcripts@usc.edu.tt):

- Your Name, USC ID Number, Personal Phone Number (preferably mobile), Degree Earned, Complete address (no P.O. Boxes) to which the diploma is to be mailed and students' signature

In-person Collection - Diplomas can also be collected from the Records Office. *Hours of Operation*: Monday – Thursday 9:00 am - 12:30 pm and 1:30 pm - 4:30 pm and Friday - 9:00 am - 11:30 am.

Proxy Collection - Students can also have someone collect diplomas on their behalf. A **signed authorization** letter and proof of person (National ID Card or Passport) must be presented to the Records Officer. The authorization letter can be emailed in advance but **MUST** have a signature.

NB: Please note that your diploma can only be released if you have Financial Clearance.
