Methods of Social Research I **MUST** be completed in your second year.

Methods of Social Research II **MUST** be completed in your third year.

Methods of Social Research III **MUST** be completed in your fourth year.

Only ONE research course can be taken in one semester. Students will NOT be allowed to do two research courses in one semester.

Methods of Social Research I, II and III are NOT offered in the 3rd semester (i.e. Summer Classes), they are ONLY offered in the first and second semester in an academic year, please be guided.
