Registration

Registration for the Conference will only be considered completed upon payment of the appropriate fees and registration for the event. You will be directed to the registration portal after submitting the payment form.

An e-mail confirmation will be issued for each registrant upon completion of registration. Ensure the correct email address(es) is/are entered to receive your confirmation.

The USC Planning Committee ("Committee", "us", "we", or "our") reserves the right to close or reopen registration at any time before or after the advertised deadline.

The Committee also reserves the right to make alterations to the programme, format, date and/or venue at any time without prior notice.

The Committee is not responsible for any loss or damage as a result of substitution, alteration, postponement, or cancellation of the Conference due to causes beyond its control - including without limitation, force majeure, natural disasters, sabotage, accident, trade or industrial disputes, terrorism, strikes or hostilities.

The Committee will not accept any liability for personal injuries, or loss or damage to property belonging to attendees, either during, or as a result of, the Conference.
